CLOTHING

(Depends on City Climate)

China's weather varies a lot by region:

- North (e.g., Beijing): very cold winters
- Central (e.g., Shanghai): mild winter + humid
- South (e.g., Guangzhou): warm + rainy

Pack accordingly:

- Winter jacket (heavy if north, medium if central)
- Sweaters / hoodies
- Thermal wear (2–3 sets if cold region)
- Light clothes (for warmer months)
- Comfortable daily wear
- Raincoat / umbrella (very important)
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Formal outfit (presentations/events)



ROOM ESSENTIALS

- Bedsheets & pillow covers
- Blanket / light comforter
- Towels
- Slippers
- Laundry bag
- Extension board (China plug types A/I/C)
- Toiletries
- Storage organizers



KITCHEN BASICS

(Some dorms may not allow cooking)

- Basic spices (limited)
- Ready-to-eat food (first few days)
- Plate / bowl / spoon / chopsticks
- Lunch box
- Water bottle

Tip: Food is easily available and affordable in China.
